Common PAT Testing Questions

Q What is PAT testing, and why is it important for care homes?

A PAT (Portable Appliance Testing) involves checking electrical appliances to ensure they are safe to use. In care homes, PAT testing is crucial to protect residents, visitors and staff from potential electrical and fire hazards, and to comply with safety regulations.

Q How often should residents' appliances be PAT tested?

A Typically, care homes test residents' appliances when they first arrive, then perform annual checks. Additionally, any new appliances brought in during a resident's stay should be tested before use.

Q Can non-electricians perform PAT testing in our care home?

A Yes, they can — provided they receive the appropriate training. According to the Code of Practice for In-Service Inspection and Testing of Electrical Equipment (5th Edition), the person performing PAT testing must be a "competent person". Our comprehensive training courses equip your staff with the skills and certification to carry out PAT testing in compliance with the regulatory standards.

Q What support does First Stop Safety offer if we encounter issues during testing?
